Artwork Submission Terms and Conditions for The Art of Rescue

By submitting artwork to Northwest Boxer Rescue (NWBR) for participation in *The Art of Rescue*, the artist (or the artist's legal guardian, if under 18) agrees to the following terms:

- 3. Return Policy: Submitted artwork will not be returned to the artist under any circumstances.
- 4. **Donation Acknowledgement:** A donation receipt for the submitted artwork is available upon request. Artists seeking a receipt must contact NWBR at the time of submission
- Content Restrictions: Any submission containing material deemed inappropriate, offensive, or otherwise inconsistent with NWBR's
 mission and values will be disqualified at the sole discretion of NWBR.

Eligibility

Open to all individuals regardless of age or experience level. Artists under the age of 18 must have parent or guardian consent to participate.

7. Submission Requirements

All entries must feature a Boxer dog as part of the design. Submissions must be original, previously unpublished, and created solely by the artist. AI-generated images or plagiarized content will be disqualified.

8. Submission Format

Artwork may be submitted in digital form (photograph or scanned image of the piece). High-resolution files (minimum of 300 dpi) are encouraged to ensure print quality if selected.

Deadline

10. Judging Criteria

Artwork will be judged based on creativity, emotional impact, originality, and adherence to the theme. Judges' decisions are final.

12. Intellectual Property and Rights

By submitting artwork, artists grant NWBR a perpetual, royalty-free, worldwide license to use, reproduce, publish, modify, and display the artwork in any format or media. Artists agree that NWBR may alter the artwork for print or digital presentation if necessary.

13. Artwork Handling and Ownership

All submitted artwork becomes the property of NWBR and will not be returned. NWBR is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged artwork.

14. Use of Personal Information

Personal information collected from participants will be used solely for the purpose of contest administration and recognition. NWBR will not share or sell this information to third parties.

15. Right to Cancel or Modify

NWBR reserves the right to cancel, modify, or suspend the contest at any time for any reason, including but not limited to fraud, technical issues, or unforeseen circumstances.

16. Publicity

By entering, artists agree to allow NWBR to use their name, likeness, and submitted artwork for promotional purposes without further compensation.
